## Town of Lyme Local Law 2025Three Mile Point Restricted Parked

<u>Article 1. - Statement of Authority.</u> The Town Board of the Town of Lyme, pursuant to the authority granted it under Article 41 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, hereby enacts as follows:

<u>Article 2. - Findings and Purpose.</u> The Town Board of the Town of Lyme hereby finds that parking on Three Mile Point between November 1st and May 1st has created a hazard by narrowing traffic and making it difficult, if not impossible, for snow removal. The Board finds it is necessary, therefore, to restrict parking on this roadway so that the Town may adequately provide safe operation of the highway and snow removal. It is the purpose of this local law to do the same.

Article 3. - Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme hereby declares:

There shall be no parking on either side, the entire length of Three Mile Point from November 1st to May 1st of each year.

The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby directed to post appropriate signage notifying the public of no parking in this area provided that the signs may be removed at the discretion of the Highway Superintendent after May 1st as long as they are put back up by November 1st of each year.

Any person failing to comply with the direction of this local law shall be guilty of a violation and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for a first violation; by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 for a second violation within a one-year period; and by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$250 for a third or subsequent violation within a one-year period. Further, if in the discretion of the Highway Superintendent, immediate removal of the vehicle is necessary to preserve public safety, the vehicle may be towed by the Town at the owner's expense.

<u>Article 4. - Severability.</u> If any part of this Chapter shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this Chapter.

<u>Article 5. - Effective Date.</u> This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State and further upon the expiration of the above noted terms.
